Minimum credits	Full-time studies are 30 credits/semester. To qualify for student accommodation, students need at least 15 ECTS credits per semester.
Language requirements	Certification of English proficiency is not required for exchange students from partner universities.
Language courses (Swedish)	“Swedish Language for foreign students” 7.5 ECTS may be taken in addition to other courses. The course is free of charge.
Course registration	Course registration opens a few days before the course starts. Students register for their courses upon arrival.
Student jobs	Exchange students and students with a study visa are allowed to work alongside their studies but it can be very difficult to find work if you do not speak Swedish.
